Summary of Events

Theft Other:

19100 W Challe Cir – Complainant reported theft of property from his vehicle. Property was stolen from complainant’s place of business.

Family Assault:

1200 Lynwood Dr - Couple in a dating relationship were involved in a physical altercation. After an investigation, no charges were accepted.

Disturbance Other:

18600 Casper Dr - Complainant was involved in a verbal altercation with a known suspect. Suspect left the scene without further altercation.

ALARMS – Contract patrol deputies responded to 7 local alarms at various locations within the community. They were handled without incident and were all found to be false alarms.

ACCIDENTS - Units responded to 2 accidents in the patrol area clearing the roadway and charging the individuals at fault in the wrecks. Safety was restored and traffic was brought back to a normal pace.

MUD CHECKS – Contract patrol deputies made 58 Municipal Utility Checks within the community. There were no signs of foul play and all facilities appeared to be in good working order.

OTHER CALLS - Contract and District patrol deputies responded 47 to other calls for service within the community, while maintaining peace and justice in the contracts.

SUSPICIOUS VEHICLES – Contract patrol deputies responded to 9 suspicious vehicles within the community. All these scenes were utilized to gather intelligence and were all cleared without incident after thorough investigations.

TRAFFIC – Contract patrol deputies made 51 traffic stops, enforcing the traffic laws of the state of Texas, within the contract reducing the possibility of accidents and lessening the chance of repeat offenders in the patrolled areas.
