Summary of Events

Criminal Mischief- 400 Dover – The complainant reported that an unknown subject had caused damage to the garage. There was no witnesses and no video footage.

FAMILY DIST. – 600 Andover – Known family members were involved in a physical altercation. The Harris County District Attorney's Office declined charges and parties were separated.

200 Bickett – Known family member was involved a verbal altercation. No criminal offense occurred. Parties were separated without further incident.

Other – 800 Lynwood Rd – A Traffic stop was conducted for expired registration . During the course of the investigation it was found that the driver was in possession of drug paraphernalia. The driver was cited and released.

E North Hill/North Fwy – A traffic stop was conducted on a speeding vehicle. The driver was found to have two open warrants from another county. The driver was taken into custody and booked into the Harris County Jail.

600 E Cypresswood Dr - A traffic stop was conducted on a speeding vehicle. The driver was found to have an open felony warrant. The driver was taken into custody and booked into the Harris County Jail

300 E North Hill - Burglary of a Motor Vehicle - The complainant reported that a subject stole property from his unlocked vehicle. The case is still under investigation.

OTHER CALLS - Contract and District patrol deputies responded to 66 other calls for service within the community, while maintaining peace and justice in the contracts.

MUD CHECKS - Contract patrol deputies made 44 Municipal Utility Checks within the community. There were no signs of foul play and all facilities appeared to be in good working order.

TRAFFIC - Contract patrol deputies made 55 traffic stops, enforcing the traffic laws of the state of Texas, within the contract reducing the possibility of accidents and lessening the chance of repeat offenders in the patrolled areas.

ALARMS - Contract patrol deputies responded to 12 local alarms at various locations within the community. They were handled without incident and were all found to be false alarms.
