## **Summary of Events**

FAMILY DIST. – 900 Lynwood - Contract patrol deputies responded to family type disturbances within the contract. No criminal offense occurred. Parties were separated without further incident.

OTHER CALLS - Contract and District patrol deputies responded to 63 other calls for service within the community, while maintaining peace and justice in the contracts.

TRAFFIC - Contract patrol deputies made 78 traffic stops, enforcing the traffic laws of the state of Texas, within the contract reducing the possibility of accidents and lessening the chance of repeat offenders in the patrolled areas.

ALARMS - Contract patrol deputies responded to 5 local alarms at various locations within the

community. They were handled without incident and were all found to be false alarms.
