The District requests that any customer receiving water from Harris County WCID 99

- Check for and repair all leaks, dripping faucets, and running toilets.

- Limit irrigation to no more than two days per week, between 7:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. following the schedules below:
 - Sundays and Thursdays for single family residential customers with evennumbered street addresses.
 - Saturdays and Wednesdays for single family residential customers with oddnumbered street addresses.
 - Tuesdays and Fridays for all other customers.
 - No watering on Mondays.
