The City of Houston and the North Harris County Regional Water Authority 'NHCRWA' have both implemented Stage 1 of their respective Drought Contingency Plans. As a customer of the NHCRWA, Harris County WCID 99 is implementing Stage 1 of our Drought Contingency Plan immediately.

The District requests that any customer receiving water from Harris County WCID 99

- Check for and repair all leaks, dripping faucets, and running toilets.

- Limit irrigation to no more than two days per week, between 7:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. following the schedules below:
  - Sundays and Thursdays for single family residential customers with even-numbered street addresses.
  - Saturdays and Wednesdays for single family residential customers with odd-numbered street addresses.
  - Tuesdays and Fridays for all other customers.
  - No watering on Mondays.
